

I design and execute original hand stitched abstract and geometric tapestries on canvas. I use a variety of complex hand stitching techniques with 100% tapestry wool yarn on canvas to build my compositions ranging in scale from 9" x 15" to 6' x 6'.

My professional training was in graphic arts and I worked in the printing and graphic design industry for over 42 years. In addition to my work in fiber art I have worked in 3 dimensional forms including clay, paper, metal and wood.
